

WHEREAS an application for certification as bargaining agent of a unit of employees of Canadian Pacific Limited has been received from the Applicant by the Canada Labour Relations Board under Part V of the Canada Labour Code (Industrial Relations);

AND WHEREAS, following investigation and consideration of the application and of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board has found the Applicant to be a trade union within the meaning of the said Code and has determined the unit described hereunder to be appropriate for collective bargaining and has satisfied itself that a majority of employees of the said employer comprising such unit are members in good standing of the applicant trade union;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered by the Canada Labour Relations Board that the Canadian Pacific Police Association be and it is hereby certified to be the bargaining agent of a unit of employees employed by Canadian Pacific Limited throughout Canada classified as sergeant, and constable, excluding superintendent, persons above the rank of superintendent, clerical staff, employees in the Special Service Branch, inspector, sub-inspector, sub-inspector and fire chief, chief security officer, storekeeper, investigator, staff sergeant, security guard, and constables holding American citizenship and employed at Brownsville Junction and Newport, Maine, U.S.A.
